**DESCRIPTION:**

Note: This is a part-time position with the potential to become a full-time position.

This is a supervisory and skilled firefighting work in directing activities of a fire company on an assigned shift. Under general direction, is responsible for fire apparatus and equipment during assigned shift; supervises personnel assigned to apparatus at scene of emergency; may drive vehicle to emergency scenes; may serve as Officer in Charge in the absence of Battalion Chief; provides fire suppression, inspection and prevention duties, and emergency rescue operations; performs related duties as required. A Fire Lieutenant reports to an assigned supervisor on administrative matters.

When arriving as the first in unit at an emergency scene, a Fire Lieutenant is responsible for establishing incident command as well as effectively deploying equipment and manpower. Depending on the scene conditions, a Fire Lieutenant may be expected to lead a crew with interior and/or exterior operations. When a higher-ranking officer arrives, a Fire Lieutenant may transfer incident command to that officer.

A Fire Lieutenant will be responsible for the training and drilling of their subordinates.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES:**

1. As Officer in Charge of a station, supervises personnel assigned to company to ensure rules/regulations and standard operating guidelines are being followed; serves as Officer in Charge in the absence of a higher authority.
2. Assumes responsibility for apparatus and equipment during assigned shift; may drive vehicle to emergency scenes; supervises personnel assigned to apparatus at scene of emergency.
3. Insures equipment and apparatus are maintained in working order.
4. Responds to fire, accident, medical, rescue, civil defense and natural disaster calls and insures that apparatus and equipment are working correctly while at scene.
5. Responds to calls regarding hazardous materials spills.
6. Performs regular fire-fighting duties; rescues victims in life threatening situations, administers first-aid when necessary.
7. Performs maintenance, including preventive maintenance, on vehicles and equipment.
8. Assists with maintaining clean facility.
9. Provides emergency medical assistance as required.
10. Attends training classes; may serve as training instructor.
11. May assist in teaching fire prevention techniques at local schools and organizations.
12. May supervise and/or perform fire prevention and inspection duties.
13. Maintains records as required.
14. May perform arson investigation duties.
15. May drive fire apparatus to fire scene.

Non-essential: None.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Training and Experience: Graduation from high school or equivalent (GED) supplemented by a minimum of five (5) year's work experience as a full-time fire fighter at a paid career fire department, in addition to a minimum of two (2) year's work experience as a full-time company officer at a paid career fire department.
