The following are the minimum requirements:

- High School Graduate or GED
- Firefighting experience preferred but not required
- Ability to successfully complete written and oral exams
- Free of criminal history and successful background investigation
- Ability to obtain Inspector's Certificate from the State Fire Marshal's Office within one year from hire date
- Valid Kentucky operator's license or ability to obtain
- Must be at least 21 years of age or 21 by hire date
