

## **REQUIREMENTS**

Successful candidates must have a high school diploma or equivalent and be at least 21 years of age. They also must have an excellent background with no felony convictions, history of criminal or improper conduct which would affect suitability for law enforcement work.

Outstanding applicants will distinguish themselves through active Kentucky Police Office, Firefighter, and/or EMT certifications. Must have the ability to interact well with the public and all airport stakeholders. Must possess a valid driver's license. If not certified, candidates must be able to obtain and maintain certifications as Police Officer, Firefighter, and EMT within one year from the date of employment.

All candidates are required to have current certifications or pass both Police Officer Professional Standards (POPS) testing and Candidate Physical Agility Testing (CPAT) as administered by the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Successful candidates will be required to complete a pre-employment/post-offer medical exam, drug screen and background investigation.

## **SALARY:**

- Public Safety Officer - Recruit (no certifications) - \$50,000
- Public Safety Officer I Probationary Officer (one or both police and/or fire certifications) - \$55,000
- Public Safety Officer II Certified Officer (all three certifications, plus promotion process) - \$60,000

Compensation listed above **does not** include Kentucky Fire Training Incentive Pay (\$4,300/annually) which will only be provided **AFTER** fire certification is obtained, by the individual.

The airport does not participate in any Kentucky state retirement program.
