Minimum Requirements:

Must have High School diploma or state-recognized equivalent

Must have a current Driver's License

Must have current CPAT (*Candidate Physical Ability Test*) Card (if applicable)

Must have six (6) years of consecutive fire service experience in Structural Firefighting

Must have two (2) years of fire service experience as an Apparatus Operator

Must have the State Required 400 (Career) Training Hours

Must be a Kentucky Emergency Medical Technician

Kentucky Fire Service Instructor 1 preferred (must obtain within 12 months of hire date)

Must have Hazardous Materials Technician Level

Must have completed NIMS 100, 200, 700, IS29, 703a, & 800.

Must pass a medical examination and drug screening.

Must pass an extensive background check including, but not limited to, driving and criminal record.

A thorough knowledge of the elements of combustion and methods of proper extinguishment.

A thorough knowledge of chemistry as it applies to toxic and flammable properties of various elements.

A thorough knowledge of fire service hydraulics and pumping operations.

A thorough knowledge of proper techniques to perform rescues and first aid operations.

A thorough knowledge of various types of building construction and related terminology.

Ability to perform difficult and dangerous work under emergency hazardous conditions.
