Looking to join one of the fastest growing departments and communities in Northern Kentucky? The Union Fire Protection District is seeking qualified individuals to fill several positions in our growing organization. The community of Union is expanding rapidly, with several hundred million in new developments. Our response area is mainly residential however, our district is quickly expanding with more commercial properties.

Centrally located in Boone County, Union Fire Protection District responds to a wide variety of emergency calls including Fire, EMS, Technical Rescue, and mutual aid to surrounding departments. Our state-of-the-art equipment includes 2 new engines, 2 new ambulances on-order, and a third fire station under construction. We operate 3 shifts on a 24/48 schedule, staffing 10 personnel per shift. If you have the desire and drive to join our organization and serve a rapidly growing community, see details below.

Benefits: CERS hazardous duty retirement, social security retirement, 100% paid health insurance, dental insurance, short-term and long-term disability, \$100,000 life insurance policy, vacation and sick time, and holiday pay.

Requirements: Kentucky certified EMT or Paramedic, KY 150-hour firefighter certification and valid CPAT card required for FF/EMT or FF/Medic position (exempt from CPAT if currently employed fulltime as a firefighter in Kentucky). Fire training hours and CPAT are not required for Paramedic only positions. The Paramedic only is a CERS hazardous duty retirement position.

Hiring Process: Candidates must successfully complete written testing, an oral interview, background check, and post job offer medical physical with drug screen.
