



Position Open: **Fire Chief**

The purpose of this classification is to plan, organize, coordinate, direct, and evaluate all activities and programs of the Fire Department to provide continuous fire safety for the city. Employee in this classification performs administrative and administrative firefighting work. Administrative duties include making recommendations concerning recruitment of personnel and purchasing of equipment, monitoring and controlling expenditures, preparing budget estimates, and assigning and supervising departmental personnel and equipment.

As with all Fire Department staff and suppression personnel, the person in this classification shall be called upon to perform hazardous duties in and around areas where fire, hazardous substances, man-made or natural disasters are occurring or have occurred

Minimum Qualifications are below:

THIS IS AN APPOINTED POSITION

- High school diploma or GED; supplemented by college coursework and basic and annual training in firefighting, emergency services, and fire service management; ten years of experience in firefighting,
- Five years in an administrative/supervisory capacity; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this job;
- Must possess and maintain Kentucky EMT-B certification,
- Must possess and maintain a valid Driver's License;
- Must possess a KY Firefighters certification;
- Valid certification in CPR; and maintain a valid IFSAC certification in Fire Fighter I and II, Hazardous Materials Awareness and Operations, Fire Officer 1 and 2, Fire Instructor 1 and 2.
- Must have completed courses and have a working knowledge of incident command, and safety officer operations.
