Minimum Qualifications:

1. 150 hour KY. certified firefighter
2. KY. Certified EMT
3. Valid CPAT Card at time of job offer (Current full-time KY. career firefighters are exempt)
4. Valid Driver's License
5. Must be willing to submit to a physical (*If currently employed by another department, a current fit for duty physical may be accepted if it is comparable to or exceeds Eastwood's current fit for duty physical*)
6. Must be willing to submit to pre-employment and random drug testing
7. Must be willing to submit to a criminal background check
8. Must be willing to work 24 hour shifts
9. Must be willing to work weekends and holidays
10. Must be willing to be assigned to an ambulance

Starting Salary - \$31,948.80

Annual State Training Incentive - \$4,000.00 – upon completion of eligibility requirements

Health Insurance – currently paid at 100% by the district.

Employee Health Reimbursement Account – 3000.00 currently paid at 100% by the district.

Dental Insurance - currently paid at 100% by the district.

Vacation, Personal, and Sick Time is provided.

Step 1 Complete and submit your application along with a resume to the Eastwood Fire Protection District. Applications and Resumes may be mailed or delivered back to the address listed above. Additional documentation you should provide includes any medical, trade, or professional certificates and/or licenses you currently possess. You will be required to show proof that you are eligible to work in the United States. The application period closes at 4:00pm EST on Friday, January 11, 2019.

***Step 2** will be a written entrance examination. Should you successfully complete step 1, you will be notified by email of your eligibility to take the written examination. The written examination will take place at Eastwood Fire Station One 16010 SHELBYVILLE ROAD. Applicants will be notified of the date and time. **The written examination will be generated from the IFSTA Essentials of Firefighting 6th Edition.** Applicants must score 70% or higher on the written examination to be eligible to move on to step three.

**(A 150 or 400-hour IFSAC I & II certified Firefighter/EMT currently employed by, or serve as an active volunteer member of a fire department located within the Commonwealth of Kentucky has the option of taking an 80% score on their written examination.)*

Step 3 is the interview process. The applicant will be required to successfully complete the interview process. The interviews will take place at a time and location determined by the Fire Chief.

Step 4 is the establishment of the hiring eligibility list. Should an applicant successfully complete steps 1-3, they will be placed on a hiring eligibility list in alphabetical order. The list will be submitted to the Eastwood Fire District Board of Trustees for approval, giving the Chief permission to hire from the list in any order. The list may be terminated by the Eastwood Fire Protection District Board of Trustees prior to its expiration.
