EMS Committee

Nick Clark said the EMS Committee met this morning. Nick said for the Hybrid EMT class, fifty eight students passed. For the Hybrid Advanced EMT class, seventy four students passed. Nick said the EMS Committee recommends hosting two refresher courses. The total cost for these courses will be \$1,500.00. Dwane Smeathers motion to approve the refresher classes. Jerry Stephens seconded. Motion approved.

State Fire Rescue Training

Marc Henderson said the Districts have delivered training to 92% of the fire departments in Kentucky. This training will continue through June 30, 2025. Marc said SFRT has purchased four additional Survival and Rescue training props. Marc said that the class 006 graduated from the Fire Academy on May 16, 2025. Thirty nine students have requested to attend class number 007.

Fire Commission Operations

Carrie Wilburn said we have hired a new Financial Analyst Melissa Norsworthy. Carrie said we hired Dustin Staves as the Training Records and Compliance Specialist.

Carrie said we are going to try to get notifications out to the departments concerning the Training Facility Grants as soon as possible. Carrie said they are working on closing out the TIC grants. The State Aid paperwork is due on July 31, 2025.

Fire Commission Facilities

Derrick Hall said there is discussion on the District 5 property. Derrick said the new ladder truck has been delivered to District 7. Derrick said we are looking at additional property for District 9. Derrick said they are looking at properties for Districts 11 and 12. Derrick said we have moved all of the equipment to the District 14 Office.

Fire Marshal's Office

Mike Haney filled a position for Hazardous Materials Inspector. They are working on the 26-27 budget years.

Kentucky Office of Homeland Security

Josh Keats said their Deputy Director is retiring. They have been working with the St. Matthews Fire Department on obtaining property.

Kentucky Firefighter's Association

Kyle Carpenter thanked everyone for coming out to the State Fire School. Kyle said the KFA Conference is coming up in Maysville from July 30th through August 3rd.

Kentucky Association of Fire Chiefs

Nathan Mulvey said the KAFC annual conference will be held in Bowling Green in August. Nathan said NERIS is replacing NFIRS. The KAFC is looking at taking over the NERIS program.

Kentucky Professional Firefighters Association

Joe Baer said they had their convention in May in Covington. The Delegates voted to endorse Andy Barr for Senate. Joe said they are working on their Legislative agenda for the upcoming session. Joe said they are working on moving tier 3 back to tier 2. Joe said they have a request for IAFF for a peer support for the Eastern Kentucky.

Marc Henderson said he has been appointed to the Cancer Support Network.
