1. Vehicle Extrication

(Saturday)

This class will be a combination of classroom and fast paced hands-on skills that will cover several different real life extrication and stabilization scenarios.

Turnout gear/extrication suit, fire helmet/hardhat, eye protection, gloves and steel toed boots required.

2. Hazardous Materials Awareness

(Friday Night)

This course will provide first responders with the knowledge and skills to: Understand what hazardous substances are and the risk associated with them in an incident; Recognize the presence of hazardous substances in an emergency; Understand the role of the emergency responder at the Awareness level, including site security and control; Have Understanding of the U.S. Department of Transportation Emergency Response Guidebook; Realize the need for additional resources, call for appropriate assistance, and to make appropriate notifications to the community. This course also includes counter-terrorism curriculum. This course meets NFPA 470 / 472 Standards, 2022 Edition and OSHA CFR 29.1910.120 (q). Additionally, it meets the requirements of the Kentucky Emergency Management.

3. DRIVERS TRAINING CONE COURSE

(SATURDAY)

This class will be combination of classroom in the morning with cone course in the afternoon.

4. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS OPERATIONS

(SATURDAY AND SUNDAY)

This HAZMAT operations level class is specifically designed for individuals who are required to respond defensively to hazardous substance releases. The course covers how to respond to and protect life, property and the environment during these incidents. The NFPA 472 Standard for Competence of Responders to Hazardous Materials/Weapons of Mass Destruction Incidents identifies the minimum competence for a responder at the Operations level. A person certified at the Hazardous Material Operations level will have demonstrated competency in the necessary knowledge and skills, to respond to hazardous materials/weapons of mass destruction incidents for the purpose of protecting persons, property and environment from the effects of the materials and shall meet the competencies at the awareness level to participate in this course.

5. ENGINE COMPANY OPERATIONS (SATURDAY & SUNDAY)

Enhance your Engine Company Operations proficiency. Learn strategic hose deployment, hose line management, search and rescue, and more. Taught by experienced Instructors, gain hands-on training in realistic live-fire scenarios. Elevate your firefighting skills and confidence on the fire ground.

Equipment Needed: Full turnout gear, SCBA and spare cylinder. All turnout gear must be NFPA compliant with no component older than 10 years. Students will not be allowed to participate if the instructor(s) find that the gear is not NFPA compliant or otherwise poses a hazard. Prerequisite: Completion of NFPA 1403 required components prior to enrolling; Live Fire Course Competency Form is required. OSHA 1910.134 (No Facial Hair impeding the seal of the facepiece)

6. BASIC AND ADVANCED FIRE CHAPLAIN (FRIDAY, SATURDAY, SUNDAY)

The Basic Fire Chaplain Training includes 2 days of course material designed to introduce the fire chaplain to ministry in the fire service. Topics included are roles of fire chaplains, how to minister to firefighters, how to minister to fire victims, critical incident stress, fire department funerals, basic fire chaplain operations, etc. **Successful completion of this class will partially fulfill the training requirements necessary to become a certified chaplain by the Kentucky Fire Commission.** This course also serves as a great annual refresher for all fire chaplains.

Advanced chaplain classes are classes expanding the knowledge base of the basic course. There are a variety of classes taught that are classified in the Advanced Level of the chaplaincy program to assist the chaplain in their growth as a minister. This particular class will discuss the stages of faith, moral injury, how the brain reacts to stress, suicide, and resiliency. These classes do NOT fulfill any requirements for state certification as a fire chaplain.

7. GRANT WRITING CLASS (SUNDAY MORNING)

Does your department need funding assistance? If so, grants are an excellent avenue to generate funding for projects, equipment, and resources. This class offers the basic concepts to help you research and write grants to obtain funding for your department.
