13 Consecutive Weeks, Monday-Friday, No Holidays or Weekends.

Meets all Firefighter Basic 2 Requirements for incentive pay (career departments).

Upon successful testing, recruits will earn the following IFSAC Certifications:

Firefighter I

Firefighter II

Hazardous Materials Awareness

Hazardous Materials Operations

Driver Operator – Pumper

Driver Operator – Mobile Water Supply

The Recruit Academy, including all meals and lodging, is provided by the Kentucky Fire Commission at no charge.

Requirements

Member of a Kentucky Fire Department (Career or Volunteer).

Valid CPAT Card.

Must be registered/sponsored by department chief, training officer, or designee.

Must live on campus Monday-Friday (13 Weeks).

Must be physically prepared to participate in daily physical exercise and strenuous hands-on training.

Departments may be financially responsible for incurred costs if a recruit is expelled or resigns.



Recruits in the Spring or Fall Recruit Academies will be eligible to attend a four-week accelerated EMT course on July 10 – August 4 at the Academy. Cost will be \$300 or less per recruit for fees. All other costs including lodging and meals will be provided. Class will be Monday-Friday 0800-1700 CST.
