

Basic Firefighting - (See List of codes)

16 hours Saturday & Sunday

This course covers 16 of the 20 recommended hours for a new firefighter in Kentucky and offers both classroom and hands-on training.

Drivers Training

8 hours Saturday

This is the Kentucky Fire Commission approved curriculum for Driver's Training. Topics such as safe operation of fire apparatus, laws regulating operation, and frequent causes of accidents will be discussed. This course has been updated to include additional information and skills on inspection of apparatus.

EMS Continuing Education

16 hours Saturday & Sunday

This course will provide the 16 hours of the NREMT 2016 NCCP Model that will meet the requirements as the national component for KY EMT recertification. Course material will be adjusted for both Emergency Medical Responders and EMT Basics. This course will also incorporate both lecture and practical experience.

Airway/Resp/Vent – P0008 (1.5 hours) Trauma – P0011 (1.5 hours) Field Triage/MCIs – P0006 (1 hour) Medical – P0010 (6 hours) Cardio – P0023 (6 hours)

Prerequisites: EMT – Basic Certification or EMT – First Responder Certification.

Fire Control (M0001/M0002)

8 Hours Sunday

<u>This is a NFPA 1403 compliant LIVE-FIRE course which will utilize Meade Co Fire Protection Districts Burn Building</u> and the Car Fire Prop:

This class will include both classroom and hands-on evolutions.

Equipment Needed: Full turnout gear and SCBA with PASS device and spare cylinder. All turnout gear must be NFPA compliant with no component older than 10 years. Students will not be allowed to participate if the instructor(s) find that the gear is not NFPA compliant or otherwise poses a hazard. SCBA cylinders must have a current hydrostatic test date.

Prerequisites: Completion of NFPA 1403 required components prior to enrolling;" Live Fire Course Competency Validation" form (page 8) must be mailed in with payment. Any student with facial hair that impedes the seal of the face piece will not be allowed to participate in accordance with NFPA Standards.

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Firefighter Survival*** - (FC10000/FC11000)

8 hours Saturday

This course is designed to help firefighters save themselves when trapped or involved in an impending emergency. The full course with skills is required for Kentucky Basic II Firefighter.

Equipment Needed: Full turnout gear including SCBA and PASS device.

Prerequisites: Permission Form if Jr. FF. Note – this is a physically demanding course.

Firefighter Rescue*** - (FC20000/FC21000)

8 hours Sunday

This course is designed for firefighters to describe and/or demonstrate techniques commonly used in firefighter rescue situations. The full course with skills is required for Kentucky Basic II Firefighter Certification.

Equipment Needed: Full turnout gear including SCBA and PASS device.

Prerequisites: Permission Form if Jr. FF. Note – this is a physically demanding course.

Flashover Recognition (FC40000/FC41000)

8 hours Saturday

This is a NFPA 1403 compliant LIVE-FIRE course which will utilize the Flashover burn trailer.

Equipment Needed: Full turnout gear and SCBA with PASS device and spare cylinder. All turnout gear must be NFPA compliant with no component older than 10 years. Students will not be allowed to participate if the instructor(s) find that the gear is not NFPA compliant or otherwise poses a hazard. SCBA cylinders must have a current hydrostatic test date.

Prerequisites: Completion of NFPA 1403 required components prior to enrolling;" Live Fire Course Competency Validation" form (page 8) must be mailed in with payment. Any student with facial hair that impedes the seal of the face piece will not be allowed to participate in accordance with NFPA Standards.

Machinery Rescue

16 hours Saturday & Sunday

This class will bring new perspectives to incidents such as impalements and other accidents that may not normally happen within a fire scene setting. Instructors will provide "out of the box" ways of thinking and help the student develop a framework of techniques and tools that will make operations smooth and safe. At the end of this class, the student will be confident in proper tool choices and confidence for on scene operations. This class focuses on hands-on training using many different types of cutting tools to complete extrication scenarios.

Equipment Needed: Safety glasses, helmet, turnout coat and work gloves.

Pump Operations

8 hours Sunday

This class will consist of hands-on evolutions of pump operations to include drafting and pumping multiple hand lines simultaneously.
